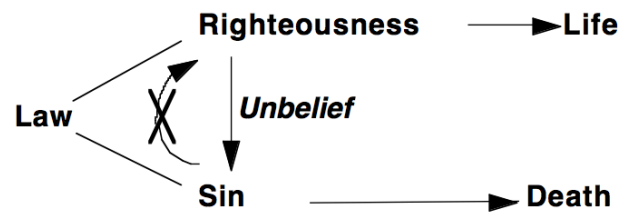
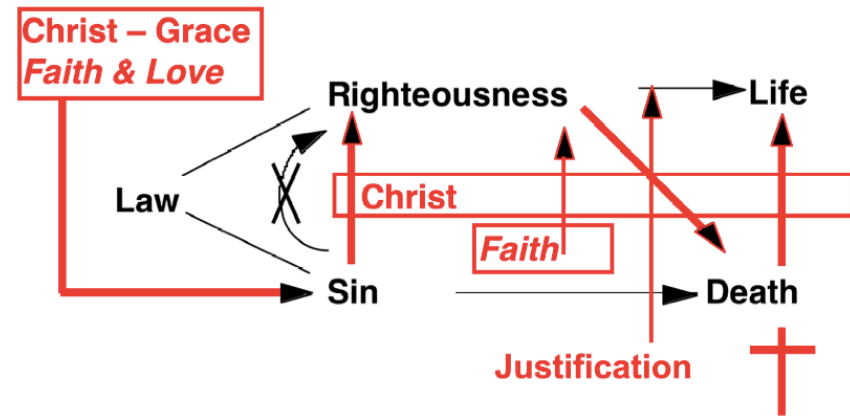


The Law



The Law and the Gospel



Law:
 Adam: created Righteous
 Fell: through Unbelief
 No way out through Law: God had to take the initiative
 Law: definitions and consequences
 Sin & Death: reason for Salvation

Gospel:
 Jesus: "having heard the word of the truth--the good news [gospel] of your salvation" (Eph. 1:13 YLT)
 John 1:17 the grace and the truth
 John 3:16 love, give
 Down: to identify with us: sin & death
 Up: victory over sin & death
This is all done by Jesus. What are we to do?
 Believe.
 Identify with Him, as He identified with us.
 Keep what He has given.

As Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so the Son of man has been lifted up, that we might look and live. There is **but one plan of salvation**. There is **but one process** by which the soul may be healed of its wounds. Look to the Man of Calvary. (RH, April 9, 1889 par. 11)

Rom. 11:26, 27 And so all Israel shall be **saved**: as it is written, There shall come out of Sion the **Deliverer** [he who is delivering], and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob: For this *is* my covenant unto them, when I shall take away their sins.

Christ ... saved the fallen race by Himself becoming the great Sacrifice. 21MR416.3 It was the love of God that saved the fallen race from eternal death (MS 136, 1902). 7BC956.7 After the fall, Christ became Adam's instructor. He acted in God's stead toward humanity, saving the race from immediate death . ST 05/29/01 par. 11 These poor souls will not be strong in God until they accept Christ as a complete Saviour . They can add nothing to their salvation . SD227.3	Jesus has saved me , though I had nothing to present to him, and could only say,-- "In my hand no price I bring, Simply to thy cross I cling ." {RH, July 14, 1891 par. 11} You need not stand where you say, "I do not know whether I am saved." Do you believe in Christ as your personal Saviour? If you do, then rejoice. We do not rejoice half as much as we should. {GCB, April 10, 1901 par. 14} ...accept...	The Lord would teach man the lesson that, though united in church capacity, he is not saved until the seal of God is placed upon him, and he is made complete in Christ . {11MR 367.2} We are never to rest in a satisfied condition, and cease to make advancement, saying, "I am saved." ... No sanctified tongue will be found uttering these words till Christ shall come, and we enter in through the gates into the city of God. ... As long as man is full of weakness,--for of himself he cannot save his soul,--he should never dare to say, "I am saved." RH06/17/90 par. 08
